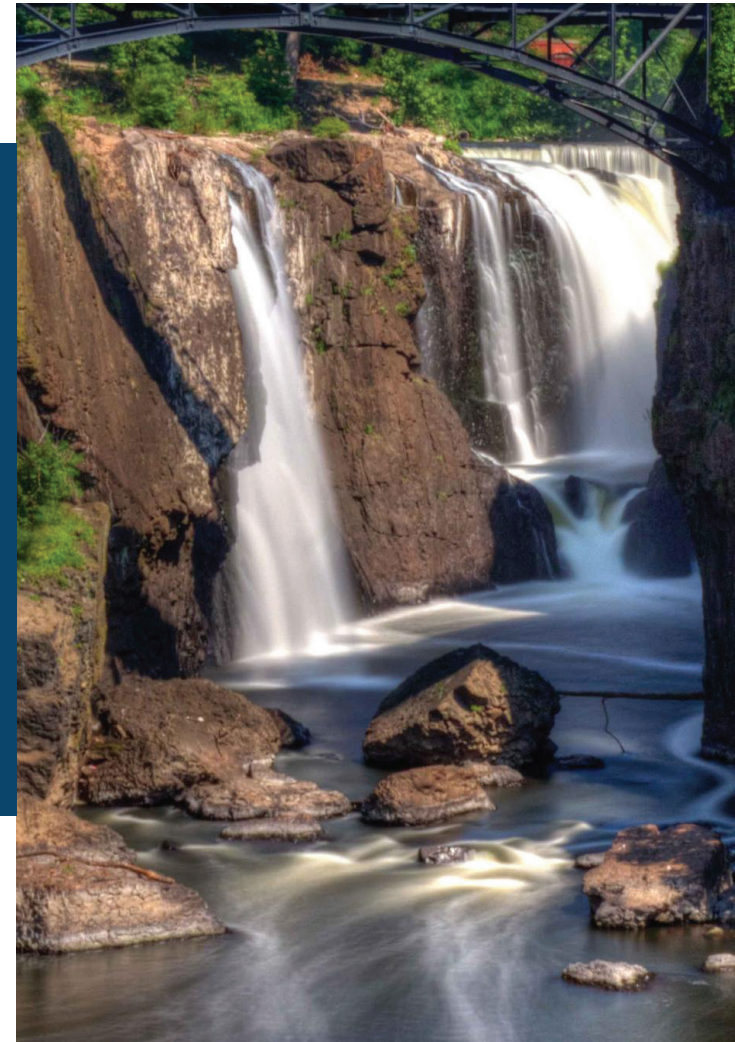

## WHAT WE PROVIDE



Our services include:

- Short-term residential care
- Outpatient and Intensive Outpatient treatment

## FINANCING OPTIONS AVAILABLE



Treatment at Turning Point is reasonably priced. We also are contracted with several funding sources in New Jersey. We participate in most major insurance plans and offer a sliding fee scale based on a client's annual income and ability to pay. Payment can be made by cash, check or credit card at the time of service. Whenever possible, those who qualify can receive funding through state and county grants.
